What is the definition of a veteran under the SSVF Program?

A veteran is a person who has served in the military and was discharged or released under conditions other than dishonorable.

What services does the SSVF Program offer Veterans' and their families?

The goal of the SSVF Program is to improve and promote housing stability among very low-income Veteran families who reside in or are transitioning to permanent housing.

We will provide outreach and case management services to, and will assist participants obtain VA benefits and other public resources, which may include:

- Deposit and/or Rental Assistance
- Utility Payment Assistance
- Purchase of Emergency Household Supplies
- Transportation Assistance/Car Repairs
- Child Care Assistance
- Moving Costs
